### **Year 3 – Forest Schools**

During the first term back in September, your child will be taking part in our brand new forest schools programme which will be led by Oak Forest School. The children who are currently in Year 2, going in to Year 3 in September, will take part in various activities including bug hunts, bush craft skills, den making and much more.

**Year 3 – Black Cap (Miss D Hale)** will take place on a Tuesday afternoon, commencing 10 September 2019 and run for 7 weeks (last session 22 October 2019).

**Year 3 – Redwing (Mr Reynolds)** will take place on a Tuesday afternoon, commencing 5 November 2019 and run for 7 weeks (last session 17 December 2019).

***Young people and accompanying adults attending forest school sessions will need to be dressed appropriately for being outdoors in all types of British weather!***

#### *Kit List (to bring for all weathers)*

- *Sturdy shoes or wellies (wellies can get cold so extra thick socks are a good idea)*
- *Long sleeved top and full length trousers.*
- *An extra warm layer and hat/gloves-fleece or wool are good*
- *Waterproof coat/jacket*

Please choose old clothing for your child to wear and reassure him/her that dirt is fine as both children and clothing are 100% washable.

***For their own safety inappropriately dressed children/adults may not be able to take part in forest school activities.  
Please do not let your child bring valuables to session's i.e. mobile phones etc as there is no guarantee of the safety of items which have a habit of getting lost.***

Please ensure your child has their kit with them each week to enable them to take part.
