In English we will be creating pieces of work of different genres. These will include, narrative, diaries, letter writing and poetry. Children who read regularly progress faster in English than those who do not. We recommend that you read with your children at least 5 times a week.

We will enhance this learning with a visit from a Roman character to bring the stories we are looking at alive.
