

Homework expectations

Dear Parent,

Homework will be sent home with your child on a Wednesday and we will expect for this to be returned on a Monday. This will allow teachers to mark your child's homework in time to resend the book for the next week's homework. In the event of this homework being returned late, it may not be marked when the book is next sent home if time does not allow for this.

On a weekly basis, you can expect your child to receive the following as homework:

- Reading or phonics
- Spellings – a list of recommended words can be found in the back of the homework book for additional spellings
- Mental recall of maths facts

Your child's teacher may also send a selection of the following as homework:

- Reading comprehension
- Maths in relation to the week's work
- Topic or Science research or task

All homework tasks will be glued in on the left hand side of the book, with the right hand side of the book to be used to record responses to homework.

Reading records

Your child will also be provided with a reading record for you to communicate to the teacher successes and areas your child needs to improve in. This reading record will only be for the use of parents, carers or other family member to record when your child has read. School staff will keep electronic of reading progress on school assessment systems.
