Dear Parents,

As part of our Christmas topic, the children in Reception have the opportunity to visit Piglets Farm. The children will be writing Christmas letters in school to take with them and will receive a special gift while there.

The visit will take place on Tuesday 10th December 2019. We will leave school at 9.00am and return at approximately 3.05pm. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle for the day.

The children will be expected to wear school uniform but must also bring a warm, waterproof coat and adequate footwear as we will mostly be outdoors (ie wellies).

The actual cost of the trip is £22.00 per child. This must be paid before Friday 29th November via our online payment system, Parent Pay. Unfortunately, if parents are unable to contribute this amount for their child we will not be able to organise the visit. There is no longer any entitlement to funds from the Local Authority to help parents on low incomes to contribute towards visits, but any parent who has difficulty making the contribution should contact school to discuss an alternative arrangement.
