Dear Parents,

As part of our Stone Age topic, the children in Year 3 have the opportunity to bring their learning to life with a visit to Creswell Crags.

The visit will take place on Tuesday 7th January 2020. We will leave school at 8.50am and return at approximately 3.30pm. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle for the day.

The children will be expected to wear school uniform but must also bring a warm, waterproof coat as some of the activities are outdoors.

The children will need to arrive at school at 8:30am so we can register the children before getting on the coach. This is due to the need to arrive at Creswell Crags by 10.00am.

The actual cost of the trip is £17.00 per child. This must be paid before Friday 6th December via our online payment system, Parent Pay. Unfortunately, if parents are unable to contribute this amount for their child we will not be able to organise the visit. There is no longer any entitlement to funds from the Local Authority to help parents on low incomes to contribute towards visits, but any parent who has difficulty making the contribution should contact school to discuss an alternative arrangement.
