Dear Parents,

As part of our topic 'Fight to Survive', the children in Year 6 have the opportunity to visit the Holocaust Centre in Newark. The children will be able to learn and have more understanding of the Holocaust through a more immersive viewpoint of a child.

The visit will take place on Monday 27th January 2020. **We will leave school at 8.30am prompt, therefore, all children will need to be in school no later than 8.15am, we will return at approximately 3.30pm depending on traffic. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle for the day.**

The children will be expected to wear school uniform and sensible shoes.

The actual cost of the trip is £16.00 per child. This must be paid before Friday 20th December via our online payment system, Parent Pay. Unfortunately, if parents are unable to contribute this amount for their child we will not be able to organise the visit. There is no longer any entitlement to funds from the Local Authority to help parents on low incomes to contribute towards visits, but any parent who has difficulty making the contribution should contact school to discuss an alternative arrangement.
