Time	Suggested Activity	Ideas
Before 9am	Wake up	Eat breakfast, make your bed, brush your teeth, get dressed
9-10:30am	Academic Time	School pack - Phonics and Literacy activities, online websites/videos
10:30-11am	Break Time	Fresh air in the garden or one of the '100 indoor ideas'
11-12am	Creative Time	Drawing, painting, crafting, games, baking, play music
12-12:30am	Lunchtime	Help prepare/tidy away
12:30-1:30pm	Quiet Time	Reading (Oxford reading tree, Vooks for Audio books), Mindfulness coloring, resting
1:30-3pm	Academic Time	School pack - Math's, online websites/videos
3-4pm	Outdoor Time	Indoor or garden exercise activities/games
4-8pm	Free Time/TV	Bath/shower, brush teeth, watch your favorite TV show or film, story time, bed time

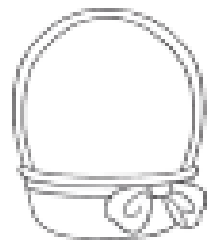
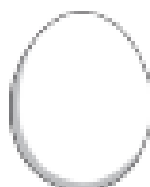
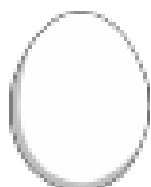
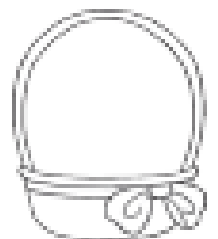
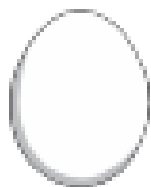
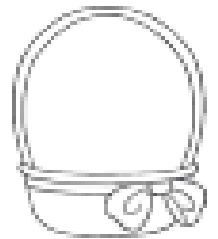
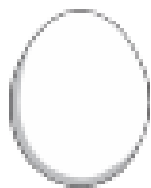
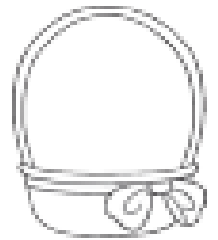
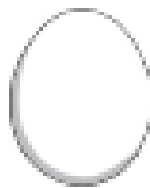
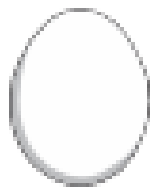
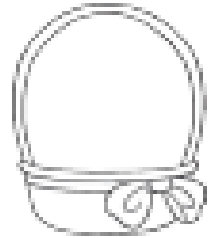
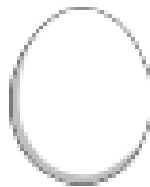
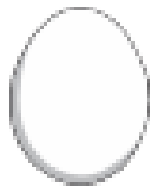
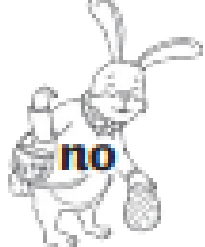
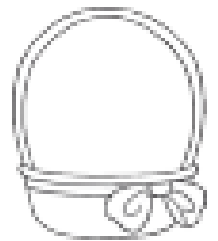
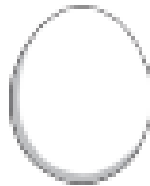
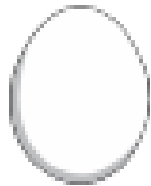
Expressive Arts and Design

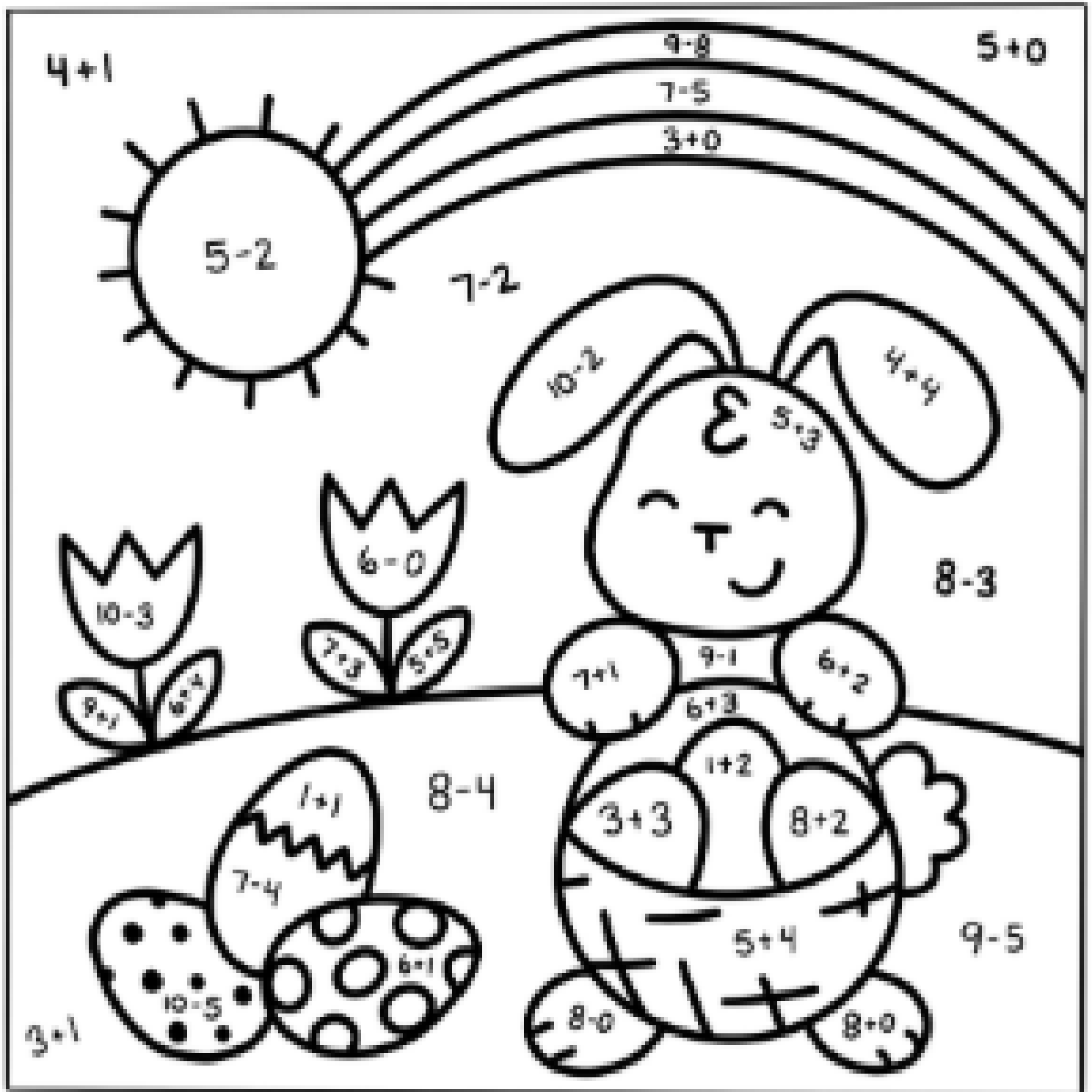
Easter Chick Tricky Word Writing

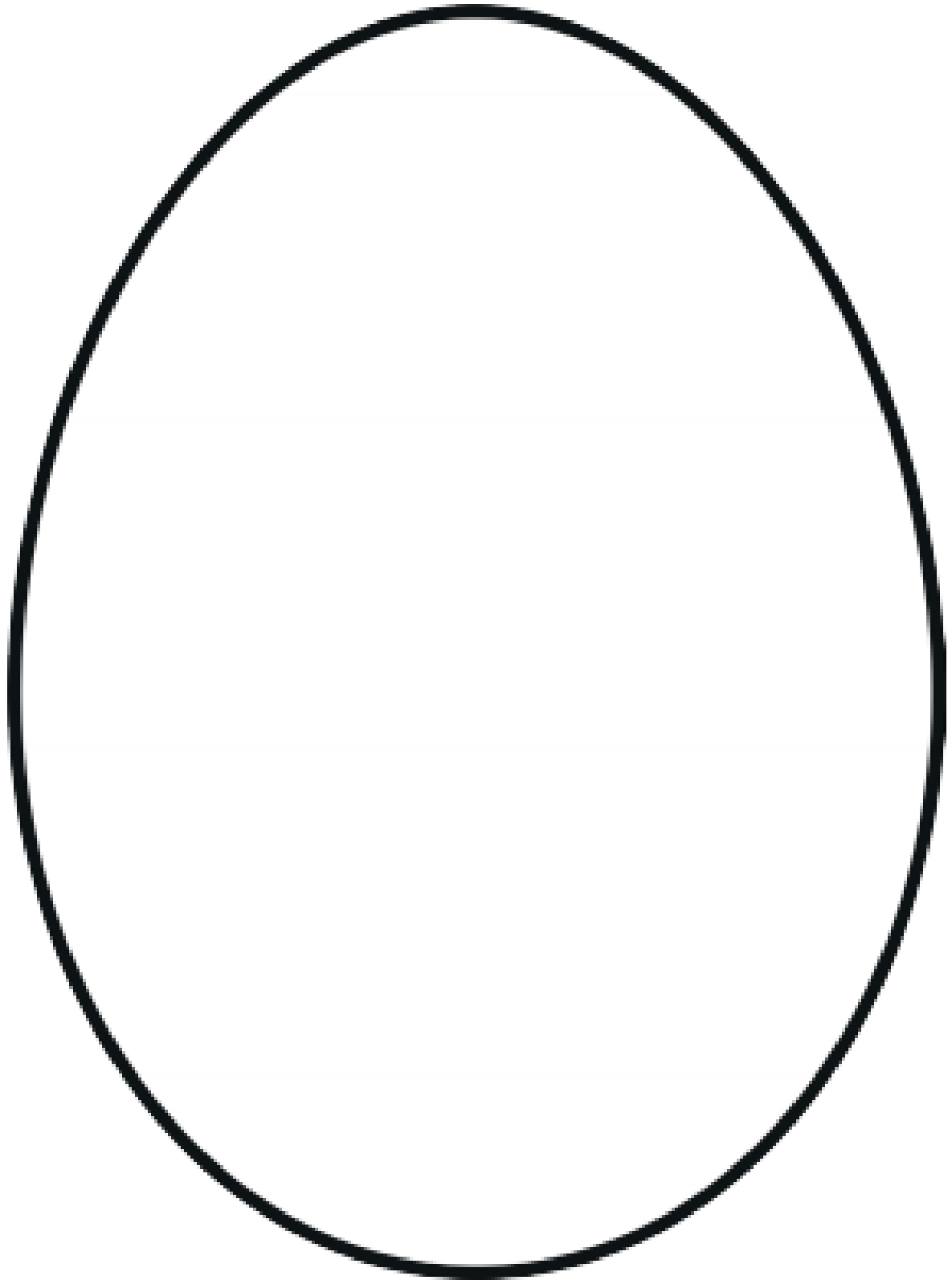

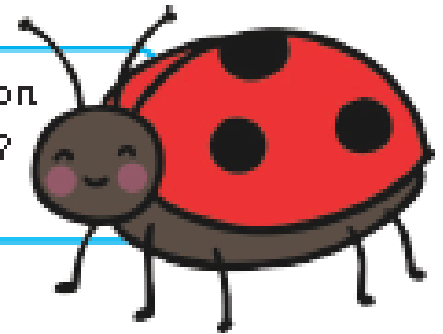




Solving Problems - Doubling

Home Learning Challenges

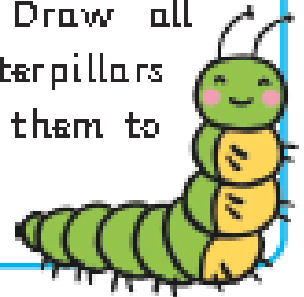
If a ladybird has 4 spots on one side and 4 spots on the other side, how many does she have in total?
Double 4.



Collect 9 sticks. If you found 9 more, how many would you have altogether?



Draw 7 caterpillars on a large leaf. Double the amount. How many caterpillars are there in total? Draw all the caterpillars and count them to check.

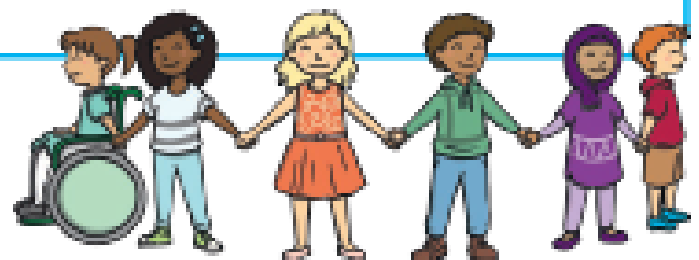


Collect 3 leaves outside. Collect 3 more. How many do you have altogether?



Jordan made 6 cupcakes for her class, but she needs to make more. There are double that number of children in her class. How many cupcakes does she need in total? Can you make that many cupcakes?

Some preschool children visit your class for an afternoon. There are usually 10 children in your class but today there are double that amount. How many children are there altogether?





Easter

Home Learning Challenge

People often celebrate Easter by eating chocolate or buns and cakes. Try making a sweet treat to share with your family. We would love to see a photo or picture of any treats you make!



Try making a model basket to hold some Easter treats! You could use an empty cardboard box and decorate it with paints or colourful Easter pictures.



Egg starts with the letter 'e' – what else starts with the letter 'e'? Write a list of other things that start with the letter 'e'. How many things can you think of?



At Easter time lots of flowers start growing in the ground and on trees. Go for a walk around a park or garden and see what flowers and plants you can see growing.



Draw or paint an Easter picture – you could draw some Easter eggs, flowers, chicks or even the Easter bunny!



If there are 10 eggs in a basket and then 5 get eaten, how many would be left in the basket? You could use your fingers or draw a picture to help you.
