



## RE-OPENING PLANS, PROCEDURES AND PROTOCOLS

### KEY WORKER CHILDREN

As you know, we have been open for key worker children since the Government closed all schools to the large part of pupils. It has been a pleasure providing this child-care for your child and getting to know them. Now that we are welcoming back pupils in Reception, Year 1 and 6, we need to put some alternative arrangements in place so that the 'bubble' of key worker children we have do not mix with the other year groups. This is to protect everyone within school.

The arrangements that will be in place will be the same model that we have adopted for all the other year groups. Staff have been placed into 'bubbles' and your child will be with the same staff each week. The key worker children will be grouped according to age group and they will receive the same education as those returning to school, as well as a balance of child-care. We have adapted one of our classrooms so that those in Nursery and Reception can continue to learn through play and continuous provision, and those in key stage 1 and 2 can access some formal lessons. We will ensure that this is at a 2m distance, as well as encouraging one child to access areas of provision.

Staff in bubble 1 will be with the Early Years and Key Stage 1 children on a Monday and Tuesday, and staff in bubble 4 on a Thursday and Friday. Staff in bubble 2 and 3 will be with key stage 2 children, with bubble 2 at the beginning of the week and 3 at the end of the week. Support staff will be with the children on a Wednesday so that teaching staff can plan work for the key worker children as well as their own year groups.

### DROP-OFF AND COLLECTION

Your child will need to be brought to the site entrance on Wood View Crescent (**nearest the field**) for 8:45am. The member of staff allocated to your child's 'bubble' will be there to greet them at the gate. We must ask that you do not enter the site in order to minimise the number of people entering the site, and ask that you wait on the pavement on approach to the gate by ensuring social distancing of at least 2m.

Your child will need to be collected at 3:00pm. At the end of the day, your child will be accompanied by the member of staff to the gate. Once again, we must ask that you wait for your child on the pavement on Wood View Crescent and ensure that you socially distance.

### UNIFORM

There will be no requirement for your child to wear uniform but please ensure they are wearing clean clothes daily in order to minimise risk. On a daily basis, they will have a PE session, therefore it may be best to send them in active wear and trainers.

### LUNCHTIME

Our school kitchen will be back up and running as of 8<sup>th</sup> June and your child is more than welcome to have a school dinner at a cost of £2.10 payable through ParentPay. However, there will not be a requirement to pay for this if your child is eligible for universal free school meals (Rec, Y1 and 2) or benefit led free school meals. If you prefer to send your child with a packed lunch, we need to ask that this is brought in disposal bags or foil so that this can be thrown away as soon as they have eaten.
