Dear all



## Remote Learning Feedback

We have recently reviewed our practice for feedback whilst completing remote learning.

On a daily basis, we ask that all pieces of work are 'handed in' by 5pm. Feedback will be provided on each piece of work by lunchtime the following day. This will either be a typed comment or a voice recorded comment.

We know it may be difficult for some parents to



support their child to upload the work by 5pm due to work commitments. Please don't worry about this. You can still upload after this time.

## Access to devices

During the previous school closure, we received 23 Chromebooks through the Government scheme. We have also been able to loan 15 tablets from Castleford Heritage Trust.

Yesterday we received a visit from staff at the local

distribution centre for TKMax, who donated 4 brand new laptops for the school to support remote learning. This was arranged by one of our parents. We are so grateful for this generosi-



ty, as it enables us to support an increasing number of families.
